Dore village parking

Additional submission received at public meeting 18 January 2012

Problem

Dore village has no public parking facilities. Typically roads are narrow and the village has shops, houses, churches, pubs and a bus terminus all competing for frontage. Limited open areas are mostly privately owned. Demand for parking space arises from:

- o house owners
- o people visiting shops
- o people catching bus into town
- o people working in village.

Solutions

- Establish public car parks anywhere within say 0.5 mi of village centre. Limit parking in village streets (say 30 mins).
- Move bus terminus (with adjacent parking) to outskirts of village but retain route through village.
